This increase was necessary to keep up with the rising costs for landscaping, insurance, and just about everything else the HOA pays for. Last autumn's inspection turned up a number of properties which had problems, most of which were minor. Sadly, during a follow-up inspection in December, it was noted that only about half of the problems had been corrected. With the general aging of the properties in our community, and apparent homeowner apathy, an annual inspection has now become necessary. We have decided that spring is really the best time to conduct the community inspection. So, look forward to another inspection this spring (in May), and each spring from now on. The HOA board members conducting the inspection will especially be looking at:

- Proper care and maintenance of yards and landscaping
- Paint that may be peeling or flaking (on doors, windows, foundations, etc.)
- Mildew or mold on decks, fences, and siding
- General fence and deck condition

I would like to thank Lewis Sarver for agreeing to take over the board position vacated by Doug Kornreich last year. If you would like to become more involved in our community, please consider running for one of the two board positions that are up for election this year.

Lastly, don't forget to attend the upcoming annual meeting on April 5th. I hope to see you there.
