Community News

Cavey Property

The Cavey property located across Route 103 from the end of Wesley Lane closest to Route 100 is approximately 25 acres in total. The owners have proposed building an apartment complex called 'The Park at Locust Thicket' that would consist of 387 units and an office building (probably to be used for medical offices).

The only entrance to the property would be directly opposite Wesley Lane. A number of road improvements will need to be made to the intersection there and to Route 103 as it goes over Route 100. The current probability is that the State Highway Administration in conjunction with Howard County will remove the current traffic circles and replace them with a diverging diamond intersection.

The owners do not currently have a timetable for when they will begin construction, though they would like to start as soon as possible. The Howard County Department of Planning and Zoning gave approval to preliminary site development plans in September 2016 and the Howard County Council approved some money for the changes to the Route 100/103 interchange in the current year budget.

Urick Property

The Urick property is located off of Coxwold Drive between Pennell Court and Woodvale Place and is approximately 2 acres. Entrance to the property is through a small parcel of Willowood HOA owned land on Coxwold Drive. The owners are currently offering the land for sale with the hope of selling to a developer who would build an unknown number of townhouses or single family homes on it. The HOA would love to be able to purchase this land to keep it from development, but does not have the money to do so.
